

SUBJECT PRONOUNS AND POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVES

Subject Pronouns: Use subject pronouns BEFORE the **VERB** in a sentence.

I	You	He	She	It	We	They
---	-----	----	-----	----	----	------

Example: **I** eat pizza every day.

Useful Language:

Verb – Action word.

Noun – Person, place, thing

Own – tener, poseer, riêng

Possessive Adjectives: Use possessive adjectives BEFORE the **NOUN** it owns.

My	Your	His	Her	Its	Our	Their
----	------	-----	-----	-----	-----	-------

Example: **My** car is very fast.

To use possessive adjectives: **1) replace** the subject/noun (person, place, thing) with a subject pronoun (If the sentence uses a subject pronoun, you do not need to replace).

Example: Mary has a blue dress. ~~Mary~~ **She** has a blue dress.

Then **2) match** the possessive adjective with the subject pronoun.

Example: Mary has a blue dress. ~~Mary~~ **She** has a blue dress. That is **her** blue dress.

Subject Pronoun/Possessive Adjective Match

SP	PA		Replace Nouns (person, place, thing) with subject pronoun.	Match: PA comes BEFORE the noun.
I	My	I have a dog.		This is my dog.
You	Your	You wrote a book.		I read your book.
He	His	John baked a cake.	John He baked a cake.	Mary is eating his cake.
She	Her	Donna has a phone.	Donna She has a phone.	Donna lost her phone.
It	Its	The car has a radio.	The car It has a radio.	This is its radio.
We	Our	Dan and I own a store.	Dan and I We own a store.	The man robbed our store.
They	Their	Ann and Sam have a dog.	Ann and Sam They have a dog.	This is their dog.
