Definitions	Discourse Type
The use of sensory details in adjectives and adverbs to give the reader a vivid idea of what is being discussed.	
Tells a story.	
Using facts to defend a point of view and to change another's mind	
Writing that influences or changes the behavior of the reader through the use of pathos (appeals to emotions), logos (appeals to reason) and ethos (appeals to ethics)	
Writing that gives information or explains a concept	
Writing that intends to tell the life of a character through the use of dramatic elements	
Writing that reflects intense feeling through the use of poetic techniques	
Encompasses all types of writing that is in paragraph form
