What are Farm Animals?

Farm animals are animals raised or kept primarily to consume (eat), to be used to make money and to help with certain work around the farm. Another name for them is Livestock.

Examples of Farm Animals

Farm animals are animals kept or raised on farms. The common ones are goat, sheep, cow, camel, horse, donkey, pig, chicken, turkey, duck, and goose_etc.

Farm animals are bred for many purposes. Chickens give us our eggs, cows and goats provide us with nutritious milk. Different breeds of sheep produce many kinds of wool fibres which are made into clothing. Horses are used as working animals, sports and leisure activities.

However, all these animals are not just there to provide us with materials, aid and provisions, they also make wonderful pets which give us years of pleasure and devotion. Farm animals like dogs and cats make a great companion. Dog is best known for being faithful, loving and sincere towards their master. They can be trained easily and trusted.
