3. Early in the morning, Samuel sat outside his cabin to watch the squirrels. He saw 4 crawling in the trees and 3 more playing around on the rocks. In all, how many squirrels did Samuel see?

4. For breakfast, Jim's cabin ate a total of 9 pancakes, and Mark's cabin ate 7. How many pancakes were eaten altogether?

5. During activities at the lake, Earl and Mark decided to skip rocks on the water. Earl's rock skipped 7 times, and Mark's skipped 6. How many times did their rocks skip altogether?
6. During rope climbing activities, Eva was able to climb up to the top 3 times. Her friend Alison was able to climb up twice. How many times were they able to reach the top?
7. Steve's cabin went horseback riding. They took the path around the lake, which was a distance of 2 miles. Then, they rode along the trail with the blackberry patch, which was a distance of 1 mile. How many miles did they ride in all?
8. Around the campfire, the children sang 6 folk songs and 6 very silly songs that made everyone laugh! How many songs did they sing in all?
9. During free time, some of the campers decided to pretend to be different animals! Five children chose to be deer, and 4 chose to be rabbits. How many children played this game altogether?
