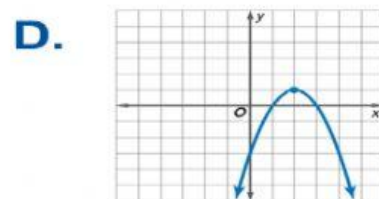
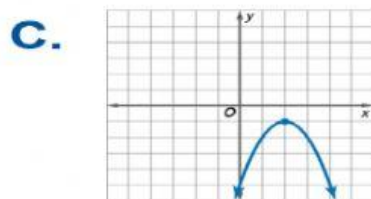
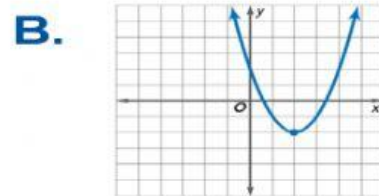
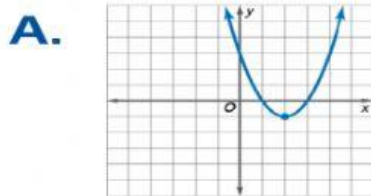


Lesson (2-4) Algebra 2
