Before they were STARS

In 2000, **Hugh Jackman** played the part of Wolverine in *X-Men*. The movie was very successful, and he was the star of eight more *X-Movies* in the 2000s and the 2010s. But Hugh had other jobs before he was an actor. When he was only eighteen he moved to England from Australia. He was a teacher in a very expensive school. His students liked him very much, but after a year he moved back to Australia.



These days everyone knows **Lady Gaga** for her music, her amazing shows, and her interesting clothes. She sells millions of records and she works for a lot of charities. On December 11, 2015, people chose her as the "Woman of the Year, 2015". But before she was famous, when she was in school, she worked as a waitress near her home in New York.
