
What are the parts of a flower?



Name of reproductive part	Function
	Holds the anther up
	The egg cell. This will become the seed when it has been fertilised.
	Small leaves under the flower, which protected the flower bud.
	Produces the male reproductive cells, pollen.
	Contain the female reproductive cells or ovules.
	The structure between the ovary and the stigma.
	Attract insects to the flower.
	The place where pollen lands for pollination to occur.
