 study → **studied** play → **played**
 dance → **danced** live → **lived**

IRREGULAR VERBS:

- + Subject + V **2ND column**
- Subject + **didn't** + Verb
- ? **Did** + Subject + Verb ?

begin → **began** break → **broke**
 come → **came** eat → **ate**
 go → **went** see → **saw**
