

## INDIRECT QUESTION'S ACTIVITY

This activity can help students to present and practice indirect questions (for asking information)

<p>Indirect questions are more polite than direct questions. They are introduced by phrases such as:</p> <p>Can / Could / Would you tell me...?          Can / Could / Would you inform me...?          Can / Could / Would you let me know...?          Do you know...?          I would like to know / ask...</p>	
<p>I would be grateful if you could tell me...          I'm interested in finding out...          Please let me know...          I was wondering...</p>

<p>In indirect questions, the word order is the same as in affirmative sentences and the tenses do not change.</p>
