Did the conclusion tie together the author's thoughts from the opinion piece?

Did the author use evidence-based terms to state their evidence?	
Did the author capitalize appropriately?	

Did the author punctuate correctly?	
Did the author check their spelling?	
Did the author eliminate unnecessary words, sentences, and phrases?
