I think I'm going to throw up. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I'm meeting my mother at the airport tomorrow. • Our grandparents are visiting us this Christmas. • I am having a party tonight. 	<p>Future events that are scheduled. (They don't depend on us).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hurry up! The train departs in 10 minutes. • I leave Frankfurt at 5 o'clock in the morning and arrive in New York. 	<p>When we think or believe something about the future. (Prediction)</p> <p>Plan for the future that you have already thought about and discussed with someone else (near future).</p> <p>For things that we decide to do now in a spontaneous way.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I'll give you a discount if you buy it right now. • I promise I will behave next time. • I'll take you to the movies if you'd like. <p>When we think or believe something about the future, there are definite signs that something is going to happen. (Evidence)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I'll buy one for you too. • I think I'll try one of those. (I just decided this right now) <p>To make an offer, a promise or a threat.</p>	<p>When we have already decided or we INTEND to do something in the future. (Prior Plan) The decision has been made before the moment of speaking.</p>			
I will be 50 next week.
