## Grammar


We use **SHOULD** OR **SHOULDN'T** to give advice. Examples:



# NEW CORONAVIRUS

## Covid-19 or 2019-nCov

### WHAT IS IT? Q.

COVID-19 is the infectious disease caused by the most recently discovered coronavirus. This new virus and disease were unknown before the outbreak began in Wuhan, China, in December 2019. COVID-19 is now a pandemic affecting many countries globally.

The infographic is divided into several sections: 'WHAT IS IT? Q.' with a virus icon; 'PREVENTION' with a shield icon; 'SYMPTOMS' with a person icon; and 'INCUBATION' with a 2-14 days icon.
