--> 명사절 접속사로 [~인지 아닌지]의 의미를 지님.

° don't know, be not sure, wonder, doubt, check 등과 함께 주로 사용됨

ex) I am not sure if(= whether) I will be attending the party.

---> 나는 그 파티에 참석할지 안 할지 잘 모르겠다.

[Whether와 if의 차이]

** if는 목적어 자리에서만 사용 가능. whether는 주어, 목적어, 보어 모두 가능

--말줄 친 접속사의 역할을 고르면?

ex) Whether she will do it doesn't matter to me. [주어, 목적어, 보어]

She knows if(whether) he got married. [주어, 목적어, 보어]

The question is whether he is guilty. [주어, 목적어, 보어]

** or not 바로 앞에는 if는 불가능, whether는 가능.

ex) I don't know whether or not he will come. (○, ×)

I don't know whether he will come or not. (○, ×)

I don't know if or not he will come. (○, ×)

I don't know if he will come or not. (○, ×)

ex) I have been thinking whether to grow my own tomatoes this year. (○, ×)

I can't decide if to go to the party with her. (○, ×)

ex) Whether we succeed or not, we will try our best.

Whether you like the city, we will go there.
