THE GIFT OF LUCKY MONEY

Many traditional customs are practiced in the Lunar New Year, the most special and important occasion in Viet Nam, like honoring ancestors' spirits, visiting close relatives on the first day of the Lunar New Year, exchanging New Year wishes with relatives, neighbours and friends, and especially giving "lixì", or lucky money, to children and elders.

This custom is a way of wishing good luck for both children and senior people during Tet. It is also a symbol of good health, success, and happiness. Local people wake up early on the first day of the Lunar New Year, put on their best clothes and the entire family, usually multi-generational, gathers in the living room to welcome the Lunar New Year. Children will respectfully fold their arms in front of their chests, and facing their parents as well as grandparents, give them the best wishes for a "Happy New Year" or "good health and longevity". The adults, in return, given them "li xi" and extend their wishes to the children for "eating well and growing up healthy" and "happiness and prosperity" for all family members. Guests give children "li xi" as well.

This custom has been practiced and preserved for years with the purpose of welcoming a new year with luck, health and success. They, the givers or the takers, are both happy to receive best regards from each other, which makes the Lunar New Year more exciting and significant to everyone.
