

BIBLE COMMENTARY

Luke 10:25–37. The lawyer—also called a scribe—was supposedly an expert in the Law and was likely trying to trap Jesus in His words.

Luke 10:30. The road from Jerusalem down to Jericho was dangerous, dropping about 3,300 feet over the course of 17 miles. Thieves often attacked and robbed travelers along this road.
