

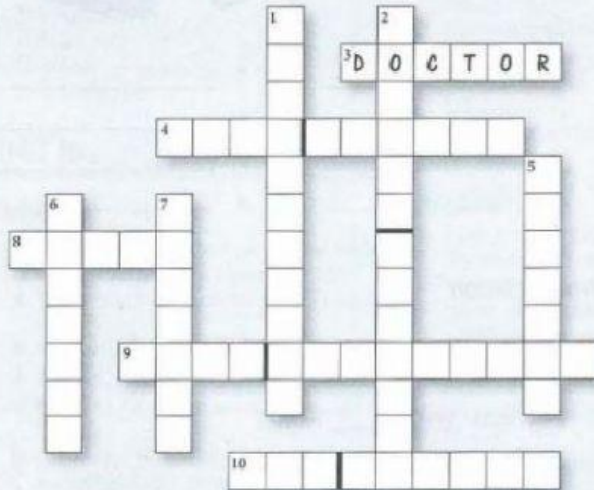
The best job in the world
