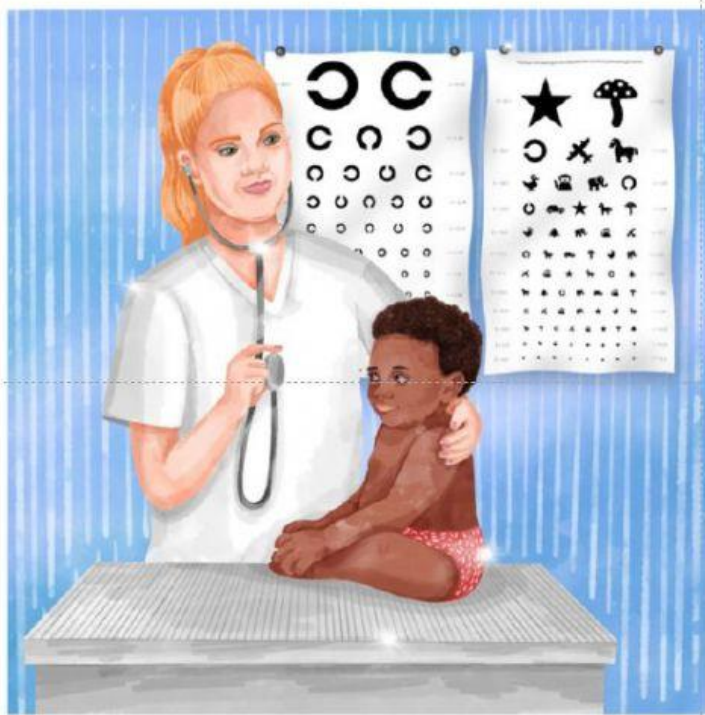

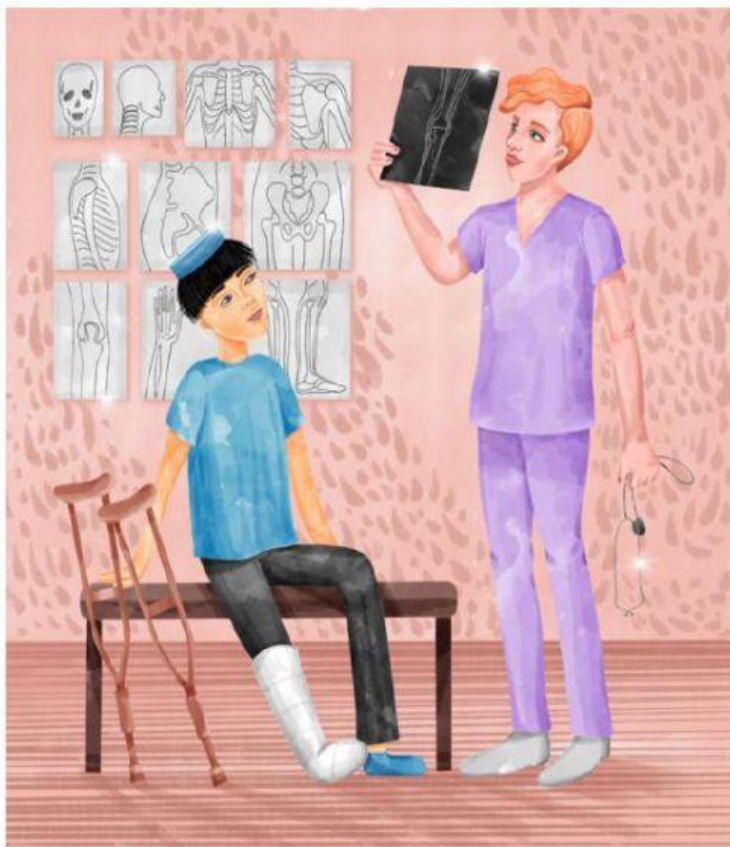

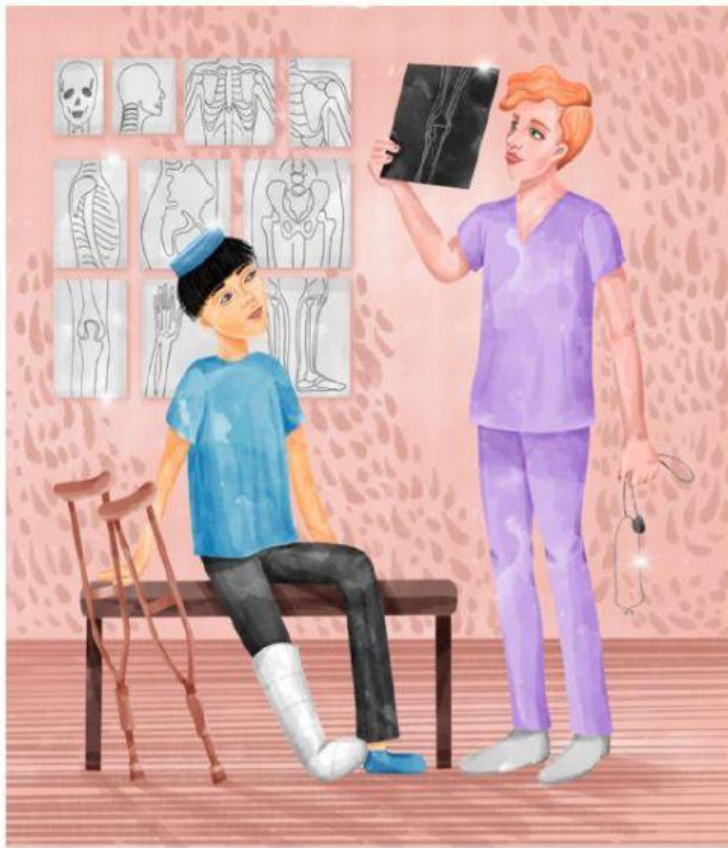

Like the clothes that we wear and the papers we read.

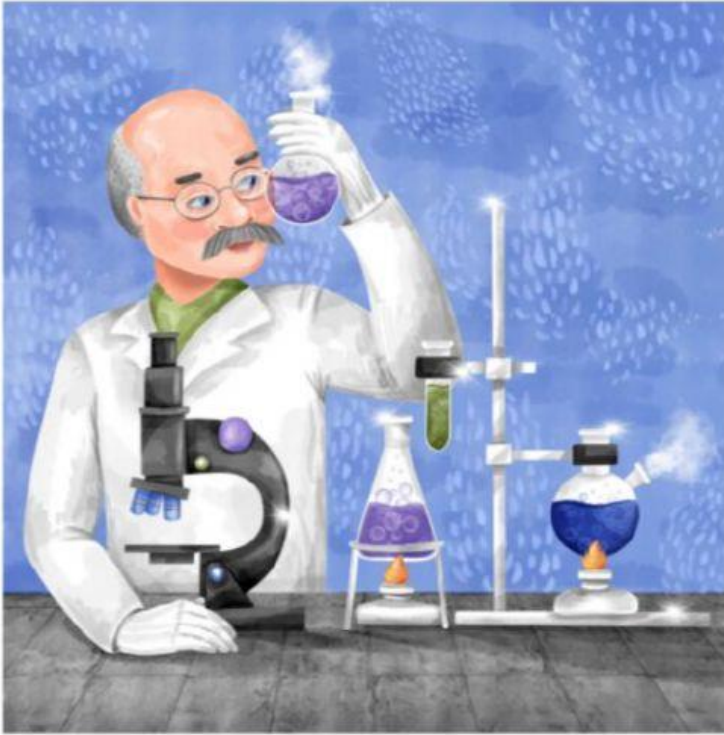
