Grenada National Bird

The Grenada Dove (*Leptotila wellsi*)

The Grenada dove is a medium-sized New World tropical dove. It is endemic or only found on the island of Grenada. Originally known as the pea dove or Well's dove, it is the national bird of Grenada. It is considered to be one of the most critically endangered doves in the world.

Bougainvilleas

Grenada's national flower is the Bougainvillea. Bougainvilleas are widely-grown and popular tropical vines whose main attractions are very colorful bracts or leaves.

Oil down, Grenada's national dish, is a melting pot of its cultural history. This hearty stew is made of local veggies, salted meat and aromatic spices. Oil down is Grenada's comfort food combining breadfruit, coconut milk, saffron, dumplings, callaloo, and a salted fish or meat.
