Life in Britain...



Homes and families

Many British people live in (a) **HOUSES**, not flats. Most houses have gardens.

Daily life

Most office workers (b) **START** work at about nine in the morning and finish at about five or six (c) **IN THE EVENING**. Most people don't go home for lunch.

People usually eat a big meal in the evening; they just have a (d) **SNACK** at lunchtime.



School life

Children start school at about nine, and (e) **FINISH** at about half past three.

Most children have lunch at school.

All children (f) **START** school when they are four or five years old, and leave when they are sixteen or eighteen.

Shops and restaurants

Most shops (g) **OPEN** at about nine and (h) **CLOSE** at about six. Usually, they don't close for lunch.

Many supermarkets stay open twenty-four hours. Most pubs and restaurants close at about eleven o'clock.
