


Subtraction Word Problem

Find the difference.



1. Jane had 8 ducks.
She gave away 5 ducks.
How many ducks does she have?

$$\underline{\quad} - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ ducks}$$

2. There are 6 ducks in the pond.
1 duck flies away.
How many ducks are left?

$$\underline{\quad} - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ ducks}$$

3. There are 9 ducks in the water. 1 duck gets out.
How many ducks are in the water?

$$\underline{\quad} - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ ducks}$$

4. There were 7 ducks playing. Then 2 swim away.
How many are still playing?

$$\underline{\quad} - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ ducks}$$

5. There were 4 white ducks in the pond.
All walked out. How many ducks are in the pond?

$$\underline{\quad} - \underline{\quad} = \underline{\quad} \text{ ducks}$$
