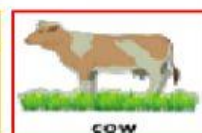
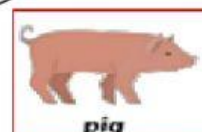

They are words that modify a noun to show a form of possession, a sense of belonging or ownership to a specific person, animal or thing.

- It is always used for the pronoun <i>I</i>. - It is used for singular or plural nouns. My brother is Joe. My dog is black. My cats are white.	- It is always used for the pronoun <i>you</i> in singular or in plural. - It is for male or female owners. Your phone number is on the list. Your name is Mathew. What's your last name?	-It is used when the subject is a male person. His house is near the Eiffel tower. What is his name?	- It is used when the subject is a female person. Her rabbit is small and beautiful. Her favorite music is Jazz.
Its	Our	Your	Their
- It is used when the subject is only one thing or one animal. - It is for plural or singular nouns. What a cute puppy! What is its name? The TV control doesn't have its batteries. The table has its four legs too short.	-It is used when the subject is we. -It is used with singular or plural nouns. We are rich, our house has pools and gardens. We like our school and our teachers. Our dogs aren't dangerous.	- It is always used for the pronoun <i>you</i> in singular or in plural. - It is for male or female owners. Your last names are on the list. Your names are John Mathew. What are your favorite colors?	- It is used when the subject is they. - It is used for people, animals or things. These dogs don't have their tails and their ears. The boys gave me their money for their books. The boys have their own apartment.
