HOW DO WE DEPEND ON EACH OTHER?

We all depend on our natural environment. The sun is the driving (30)_____ in all of the Earth's processes. It is the sun's rays that keep our planet warm enough for us to survive, and provide energy for the most important process as far as plants and animals are (31)_____.

The sun provides plants with the energy for photosynthesis by which carbon dioxide from the air and water from the soil are converted into the sugars and starches that make up plants. Photosynthesis only (32)_____ in plants that contain the green pigment chlorophyll. Other types of plants depend on other means of manufacturing these materials.

Animals can only live by feeding on other life forms. For example, a fox may feed on rabbits, which may eat clover. This demonstrates a simple food chain. Try to multiply this chain thousands of times to take all animals and plants into (33)_____.

Furthermore, different forms of life are not only dependent on each other for food. In our example, the clover depends on bees for pollination- without which the clover would disappear after one season. These relationships can sometimes be (34)_____ with far reaching effects. Should the bees become reduced in number, the amount of clover would fall back and the rabbits might be forced to feed on crops grown by a nearby farmer. This farmer may then set (35)_____ reducing the rabbit population. If all the rabbits in an area were to be wiped out, the fox would have to feed on the same farmer's chickens instead.

Plants and animals, as well as human beings require the correct nourishment or they will become diseased. For example, some children suffer from a disease called rickets, a softening of bones due to the (36)_____ of vitamin D and sunlight.
