

Hydrometeorological Hazards

These are meteorological (atmospheric and hydrospheric) and climate events. These naturally occurring events have a negative effect on the environment, animals, and humans.



an intense circular storm that originates over warm tropical oceans and is characterized by low atmospheric pressure



a storm with thunder and lightning and typically also heavy rain or hail.



violently rotating columns of air in contact with the earth and a cloud



the landward movement of seawater caused by a strong weather disturbance offshore.



heavy rains that accompany the seasonal wind of Southeast Asia



a temporary overflow of water onto land that is normally dry.
