- 1. The largest city of the pre-Columbian era in South America, is now an archaeological site in La Libertad Region 5 kilometers west of Trujillo Peru
- 2. archaeological site containing ruins and artifacts constructed beginning at least by 1200 BC and occupied by later cultures until around 400-500 BC by the Chavin, a major pre-Inca culture
- 3. a national park and biosphere reserve located in the regions of Madre de Dios and Cuzco. It protects diverse ecosystems such as lowland rainforests, cloud forests and Andean grasslands
- 4. a series of large ancient geoglyphs in the Nazca Desert, in southern Peru. The largest figures are up to 1,200 ft. (370 m) long. They were designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1994
- 5. a 15th-century Inca citadel situated on a mountain ridge 2430 meters (7,970 ft.) above sea level. It is located in the Cuzco Region , Urubamba Province, in Peru, above the Sacred Valley, which is 80 kilometers northwest of Cuzco and through which the Urubamba river flows
