I REMEMBER I

❖ AFFIRMATIVE someone / somebody, something & somewhere

- ↳ Someone is looking through the window.
- ↳ There is something wrong!
- ↳ Your book must be somewhere in the room.

❖ INTERROGATIVE anyone / anybody, anything & anywhere

- ↳ Did anyone / anybody call you on your birthday?
- ↳ Has she come across anything interesting while cleaning the attic?
- ↳ Are they going anywhere tonight?

❖ NEGATIVE anyone / anybody, anything & anywhere + negative verb

no one / nobody, nothing & nowhere + affirmative verb

- ↳ There isn't anyone / anybody here. There is no one / nobody here.
- ↳ He didn't say anything. He said nothing.
- ↳ I haven't seen your ring anywhere. I have seen your ring nowhere.
