❖ AFFIRMATIVE someone / somebody, something & somewhere

❖ INTERROGATIVE anyone/ anybody, anything & anywhere

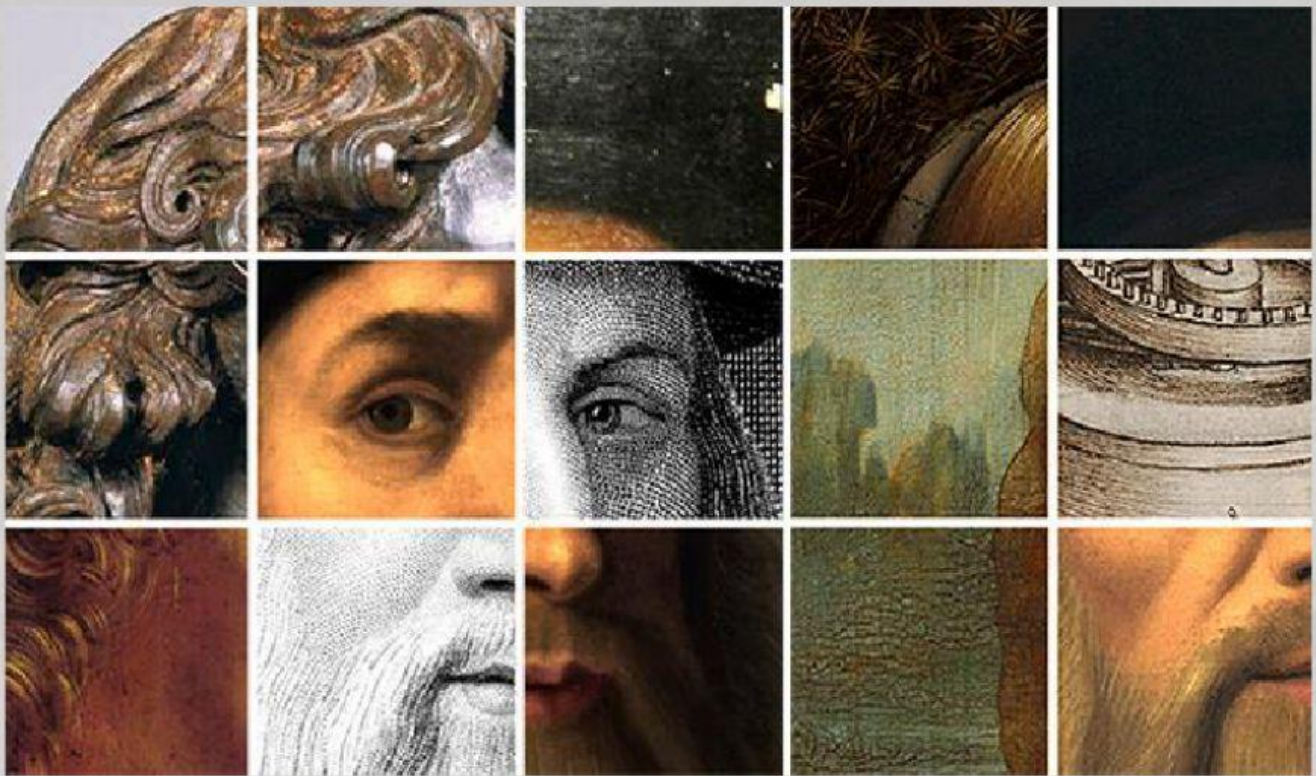
- ↳ Did anyone/ anybody call you on your birthday?
- ↳ Has she come across anything interesting while cleaning the attic?
- ↳ Are they going anywhere tonight?

❖ NEGATIVE anyone/ anybody, anything & anywhere + negative verb

no one/ nobody, nothing & nowhere + affirmative verb

- ↳ There isn't anyone/ anybody here. ■ There is no one/ nobody here.
- ↳ He didn't say anything. ■ He said nothing.
- ↳ I haven't seen your ring anywhere. ■ I have seen your ring nowhere.
