

PRESENTE SIMPLE NEGATIVA

Hay verbos que necesitan de ayuda para negar o preguntar. Son todos aquellos que no son TO BE, TO HAVE Y CAN. Ellos pueden hacerlo solos. Pero además hay que tener cuidado y fijarse en la persona. Si es HE, SHE o IT usaremos DOESN'T y se pondrá el verbo en infinitivo sin TO, con el resto de las personas DON'T.

Por ejemplo: Si es tercera persona (HE, SHE o IT) colocamos delante del verbo DOESN'T.

He **gets up** early.

He **doesn't** get up early. (Al verbo get up le quitamos la "s", ya indicamos la tercera persona en does)

She **lives** in Paris.

She **doesn't** live in Paris.

Si es cualquier otra persona (I, YOU, WE, THEY) añadimos delante del verbo DON'T.

I **live** in Maria de Huerva.

I **don't** live in Maria de Huerva.

You **water** the plants in the morning.

You **don't** water the plants in the morning.
