### The kindness of strangers

You're sitting on a train in London and you notice the person next to you is crying. What would you do if you were in this situation? Would you reach into your bag and offer them a tissue and ask them if they're okay? Would you ignore them and hope that they stop crying before the next stop? It was a situation like this that inspired a project on the London Underground called Acts of Kindness.

Artist Michael Landy regularly travelled by tube. He noticed that people seemed to disappear into their own thoughts and became disinterested in or chose to ignore what was happening around them.

One day he saw a passenger helping someone else. He became interested in what motivates people to make that split-second decision to help a complete stranger who is upset or needs help.

Landy wanted people to share their stories with him so he could illustrate them and display them in tube stations around the capital. The project is his way of drawing people's attention to the small details in our lives that make a difference: the kindness of strangers.

The main aim of his project is to celebrate kindness, generosity and compassion on the Underground. It's a reminder too that it's often the small unseen gestures that no one notices or seems to care about that can make the biggest difference to a person.

Kindness is putting other people's feelings and needs before your own and thinking about the other person more than yourself. It's also about trust: there's a risk involved in helping a stranger so it takes a brave person to make that decision. Would you do it?
