At Rubi's party, there will be three different bands to play music and a horse race in which the winner will get \$490. There are many memes (joke pictures) of Mr Ibarra's post on social media. He said Rubi's favourite meme shows Donald Trump and Mexican President Enrique Peña Nieto agreeing to allow undocumented Mexican migrants in the USA to return to Mexico for Rubi's party.
