Lotte Center Hanoi, a 272m high sky garden tower in Hanoi, Vietnam is a celebration of Vietnamese culture and sustainable design. Completed on 2 September 2014, the center features a modern architectural style designed by Callison, an American company. This tower is the second highest building in Hanoi after the Keangnam Hanoi Landmark Tower in Cau Giay district.

The tower's unique architecture is inspired by Vietnam's traditional long dress, the ao dai. Besides, the unique design with high-strength glass panels on all four sides of the building, allowing daylight in the sun, Lotte Center allows you to see the capital closer than ever before, reducing every Space constraints

Tourists can have chance to experience the transparent glass balcony, called Skywalk in this centre. With super-lightweight glass panels that can hold up to 10 people, the Skywalk gives visitors a more realistic feel when looking at this beautiful city at their feet. The balcony area is designed to allow visitors to project 360-degree visibility to the entire city. Look we are here and we can see streets and people below.

Next, board a pedal-powered cyclo for a leisurely tour around Hoan Kiem Lake. Enjoy exploring Hanoi's Old Quarter before getting dropped off back at your hotel.
