

## Rounding To Tens

Step 1: Find your benchmarks

Step 2: Find your midway point

Step 3: Check if your number is before or after the midway point

Step 4: Round to the nearest benchmark.

| Number to Round | Choose your benchmark | What is the midway point? | What is your answer? |

\*Remember if your number has 0, 1, 2, 3, 4 in the ones place, round to the smallest benchmark. If your number has 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 in the ones place, round to the largest benchmark.
