Volunteer

Founder of the Underground Railroad, a network of people who helped more than 300 slaves escape to freedom in the northern United States.

Nonprofit Organization

Working with others for a common purpose

Empathy

People living in a certain place, like a town or city

Compassion

An organization that works to help others by providing services and does not earn a profit like a business does

Generosity

Willingness to give or share unselfishly (without expecting anything in return)

Community

Caring about other people and wanting to help them when they are in need

Cooperation

Founder of several American volunteer groups, including the first volunteer fire department, a lending library, and a public hospital.

Fundraising

The quality of a person's contributions to their community

Citizenship

Raising money for a cause or purpose

Understanding and sharing the feelings of another person

Clara Barton

Giving time and effort to help others without expecting anything in return

Harriet Tubman

Founder of the American Red Cross who worked as a volunteer helping soldiers during the American Civil War
