| Words                  | Definition  |

| <b>Cycle (v)</b>       | the activity of applying scientific knowledge to the design, building and control of machines, roads, bridges, electrical equipment, etc. |
| <b>Emergency (n)</b>   | the group of people who are responsible for controlling a country or a state  |
| <b>Engineering (n)</b> | right or sensible; likely to be successful; useful or suitable  |
| <b>Fuel (n)</b>        | to ride a bicycle   |
| <b>Government (n)</b>  | a thing that is used for transporting people or goods from one place to another, such as a car or lorry                                   |
