

Modifiers of comparison: Writing Worksheet

The modifiers intensify the degree of the comparative or the superlatives. They come before adjectives and adverbs.

To modify superlatives we can use words or expressions (modifiers) like: By far, just about, quite, easily, practically, one of the.

And to modify comparatives we can use: like, a bit, far, rather, slightly, much.

The use depends on the difference, if you want to show **small differences** you use modifiers like: slightly, a little bit, not much. On the other hand, if we want to show **big difference** we can use: much, a lot, far, by far. Finally, if we want to show there is **no difference** we can use: exactly the same as, just as.
