

## Present simple tenses

**A** Kate and Amber are talking about their daily lives. Complete their conversation using the verbs in brackets ( ) in the Present Simple. Use short forms if you can.

Kate: \*Do you get up (you/get/up) early?

Amber: No, not really.<sup>1</sup> (My sister/go) to the bathroom first at about eight o'clock.<sup>2</sup> (not/get up) until about eight thirty. What about you?

Kate: Well,<sup>3</sup> (Mike/try) to get me up at about seven, but<sup>4</sup> (he/not/usually/succeed)!

Amber: <sup>5</sup> (I/be/not) very hungry in the morning. What about you?

Kate: Yes.<sup>14</sup> (there/not/be) any buses. What about you?

Amber: Well,<sup>15</sup> (my sister/want) to buy a new car, but at the moment,  
<sup>16</sup> (we/both/walk).
