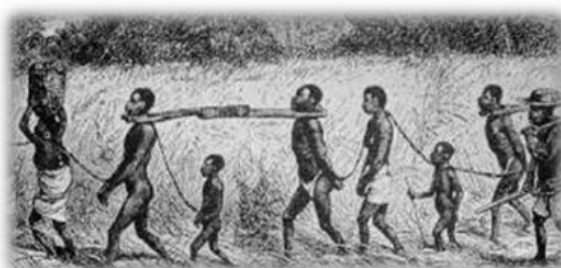




## The Middle Passage
