

More Plural Nouns


RULES

A few nouns have **special** plural forms.

The **women** and the **men** planned the event.

A few nouns have the **same** singular and plural forms.

There is one **sheep**. There are many **sheep**.



To form the plural of most nouns, add **-s** or **-es**. Nouns that have special plural forms and nouns that have the same singular and plural forms do not follow this rule.

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
woman	women	foot	feet
man	men	tooth	teeth
child	children	goose	geese
mouse	mice	sheep	sheep
ox	oxen	moose	moose
