Cold → cold + est = the coldest

Big → big + est = the biggest

TWO OR MORE SYLLABLES

Beautiful → the most beautiful

Expensive → the most expensive

ENDING -Y

Happy → the happiest

Funny → the funniest

Good → The best

Bad → The worst

Far → The farthest
