From 1914 to 1933 he took Director of the Kaiser Wilhelm Physical Institute in Berlin. He won the Nobel Prize for Physics in 1921. In 1933 he left Germany and moved to the USA, **where** he worked at Princeton from 1934 to 1945. He died in 1955.
