## Consonant Digraphs ch, sh, wh, th, ph, and Trigraph tch

Two or three consonants sometimes make one sound. The letters **ch**, **sh**, **wh**, **th**, **ph**, and **tch** make one sound at the beginning of a word or at the end of a word.
