Singular	Plural
I	We
You	You
He, She, It	They

We use personal pronouns in place of nouns:

Mary is a student. ⇒ She is a student.

The car is red. ⇒ It is red.

The girls are happy. ⇒ They are happy.

Tom and I are tall. ⇒ We are tall.

Important!

He = man/boy

She = woman/girl

They = men/women
