Nicola: It's going well, thanks.

George: I'm thinking about starting one. What do you grow there?

Nicola: I have tomatoes, cucumbers, carrots, cabbages, and broccoli.

George: Which vegetables did you try growing first?

Nicola: Cabbages. I planted the seeds in April. I gave them water two or three weeks before harvest. They were ready after about four or five months.

George: I would like to grow tomatoes and carrots. Maybe you can give me some tips.

Nicola: Sure. You should plant tomato seeds in May. They take between four and five months to grow.

George: How often should I water them?

Nicola: You should do that twice a week.

George: What about carrots?

Nicola: You need to plant them as early as possible in the spring. Don't give them too much water, though. Only water them in drought conditions. It's the same for broccoli. Those vegetables don't need much water.

George: I see. How long do carrots take to grow?

Nicola: About 90 days.

George: What do you want to try growing next?

Nicola: I'd like to grow my own lettuce.
