

CONNECTORS OF CONTRAST

- Connectors or **linkers** are connecting words.
- The connectors of contrast link opposite ideas
- There are different types:

However, ... = **Nevertheless**, ... = **Still**, ... = **Yet**, ...

They are used to express contrast.

They are used between pauses

Examples: John is extremely short., he's a basketball player.

Sharon is a very rude girl. **Nevertheless**, she

Although = **Though** = **Even though**

Used to express contrast

Used at the beginning or in mid-sentence

Examples: **Although** John is extremely short,

..... Sharon is a very rude girl,

But is the most common connector of contrast

John is extremely short, **but** he's a basketball player
