1.path(n): a. water that flows naturally along a fixed route formed by a channel cut into rock or ground, usually at ground level

2.cliff(n): b. an area of land that is higher than the surrounding land

3.desert(n): c. a plant without leaves, flowers, or color that lives on other plants or on decaying matter

4.grass(n): d. the leaves of a plant or tree, or leaves on the stems or branches on which they are growing

5.stone(n): e. large area of land covered with trees and plants, usually larger than a wood, or the trees and plants themselves


6.forest(n): f. the hard, solid substance found in the ground that is often used for building, or a piece of this

7.foliage(n): g. a low, green plant that grows naturally over a lot of the earth's surface, having groups of very thin leaves that grow close together in large numbers

8.fungus(n): h. an area, often covered with sand or rocks, where there is very little rain and not many plants

9.hill(n): i. a high area of rock with a very steep side, often on a coast

10.stream(n): j. a route or track between one place and another, or the direction in which something is moving
