

ICONS DEFINITIONS

INSTRUCTIONS: Look at the icons and match them with the corresponding definition. Then, choose the correct word to complete all definitions. Look at the example:



- 0 This symbol is the combination of “N” and “D” **who/ which** originally meant “Nuclear Disarmament”. (C)
1. People **who/ which** are lost can come to this place to ask for directions. ()
 2. This symbol represents *a room* **where/who** you can go if you have a physical need. ()
 3. This icon can be found in places for *people* **when/who** want to make calls. ()
 4. You can find this icon *in places* **when/where** people need assistance. ()
 5. You use this icon *in the moment* **when/which** you want to eliminate a document from your computer. ()
 6. This *icon*, **where/which** is a red ribbon, represents the fight for a cause. ()
 7. If you find this icon on a bin, you can put in *the residues* **which/where** can be used again ()
 8. This *virtual place* is **where/which** you can have an internet conversation ()
 9. You use this icon *in the moment* **which/ when** you want to keep a file onto your computer. ()
