GRAMMAR KEY: REMEMBER!


==> to write questions and answers in present progressive **IN ENGLISH** you need the following:

No.1 ==> A person/a pronoun or an object

No.2 ==> Verb TO BE in present tense- AM/IS/ARE

No.3 ==> A verb with ING form

Let's see how they work together, first in English and, then in Spanish:



NOW IN SPANISH:

You will need exactly the same than in English. Please see below the verb to be in Spanish simple present.

REMEMBER THAT! : Verb to be in Spanish has TWO meanings

SER AND ESTAR. THIS TIME YOU ONLY HAVE TO USE **ESTAR** as follows:

PRONOMBRE	VERBO ESTAR (To Be)
YO	ESTOY (I AM)
TÚ	ESTÁS (YOU ARE)
ÉL/ELLA/USTED	ESTÁ (HE/SHE/YOU IS)
NOSOTROS/NOSOTRAS	ESTAMOS (WE ARE)
USTEDES/ELLOS/ELLAS	ESTÁN (YOU/THEY ARE)



2	Verb TO BE in Spanish present tense	In Spanish for the present progressive we ONLY USE ESTAR
3	A verb with ING form	In Spanish this form is represented as => ANDO / IENDO
