Nature vs nurture



You know where your looks come from – for example, you may have your mother's nose or your father's eyes. But what about things that we cannot see, like your talent (0) for music? Scientists are not clear what the answer to this question (3) Those who support the 'nature' theory believe that humans are genetically programmed to behave in certain ways, regardless of culture and upbringing. On the (4) hand we have the 'nurture' theory, (5) argues that a person's behaviour and personality (6) developed by teaching and experience. There is evidence to support both of these theories and the debate (7) still to be resolved.
