Alexander Graham Bell was born on March 3, 1847 in Edinburgh, Scotland, and educated at the universities of Edinburgh and London. He immigrated to Canada in 1870 and to the United States in 1871.

In 1872 Bell founded a school for deaf-mutes in Boston, Massachusetts. The school subsequently became part of Boston University, where Bell was appointed professor of vocal physiology. He became a naturalized U.S. citizen in 1882.

Since the age of 18, Bell had been working on the idea of transmitting speech. In 1874, while working on a multiple telegraph, he developed the basic ideas for the telephone. His experiments with his assistant Thomas Watson finally proved successful on March 10, 1876, when the first complete sentence was transmitted: "Watson, come here; I want you." His subsequent demonstrations, particularly the one at the 1876 Centennial Exposition in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, introduced the telephone to the world.

He died on August 2, 1922 in Baddeck, where a museum containing many of his original inventions is **maintained** by the Canadian government.
