

Be able to use apostrophes correctly

The possessive apostrophe 's

- ∞ We **DON'T** use possessive apostrophes to show plurals.
- ∞ We use an apostrophe to show connection, belonging or possession.
- ∞ Apostrophes are punctuation marks.

For example:

The baby's name is Alice. (The name belongs to the baby).

Mrs Osman's flowers are beautiful. (The flowers belong to Mrs Osman).

The flowers are in the hospital's vase. (The vase belongs to the hospital).
