

## Be able to use apostrophes correctly

### The possessive apostrophe 's

- ∞ We **DON'T** use possessive apostrophes to show plurals.
- ∞ We use an apostrophe to show connection, belonging or possession.
- ∞ Apostrophes are punctuation marks.

For example:

The baby's **name** is Alice. (The name belongs to the baby).

Mrs Osman's **flowers** are beautiful. (The flowers belong to Mrs Osman).

The flowers are in the hospital's **vase**. (The vase belongs to the hospital).
